SPECIAL EMERGENCY MEETING

Council Chamber:

Mayor Stevenson presided at the Special Emergency Meeting of Council held on the above date and place.

Mayor Stevenson called the Special Emergency Meeting to order.

Borough Clerk VanScoy read the opening statement regarding the Open Public Meetings Act.

Members present were: Council President Giovannitti (arrived at 6:11 p.m.), Councilman Giampola, Councilman Haynes, Councilman Holloway, Councilman Kidd. Absent: Councilman DiTonno.

**PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR.**

Councilman Giampola moved and Councilman Holloway seconded to open the floor to the public. All were in favor of the motion.

Mayor Stevenson opened the floor to the public, asked anyone speaking to give their name and address and reminded everyone there was a five (5) minute time limit.

There wasn't any public participation.

Councilman Giampola moved and Councilman Holloway seconded to close the floor to the public. All were in favor of the motion.

**R. #128.16: RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF PAULSBORO.** Councilman Giampola moved and Councilman Holloway seconded to adopt R. #128.16. Roll call: Ayes: Council President Giovannitti, Councilman Giampola, Councilman Haynes, Councilman Holloway, Councilman Kidd. Nays: None. Motion carried.

**R. #129.16: RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR AN EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF PAULSBORO.** Councilman Giampola moved and Councilman Holloway seconded to adopt R. #129.16. Roll call: Ayes: Council President Giovannitti, Councilman Giampola,

Councilman Haynes, Councilman Holloway, Councilman Kidd. Nays: None.  
**Motion carried.**

At 6:08 p.m., Mayor and Council went into Executive Session to discuss an urgent safety concern of the Borough of Paulsboro affecting the health, safety and welfare of its residents.

Mayor and Council reconvened the Special Emergency Meeting at 7:09 p.m.

Council President Giovannitti moved and Councilman Giampola seconded to open the meeting to the public at 7:09 p.m. All were in favor of the motion.

Councilman Giampola moved and Councilman Holloway seconded to authorize Chief Marino to over expend the overtime budget in the Police Department without circumstances in November.

Councilman Holloway questioned how it would work.

Councilman Giampola stated the Borough could free up a few dollars, \$40,000, that would not affect the budget.

Chief Marino stated he can inform Mayor and Council of what over time money is needed. He may only go over \$10,000 to \$15,000. He assured Mayor and Council he is not one to spend money. He will keep Mayor and Council apprised of the overtime budget.

All were in favor of the above motion.

There wasn't any further business for the Special Emergency Meeting.

Councilman Holloway moved and Councilman Giampola seconded to adjourn the special meeting at 7:14 p.m. All were in favor of the motion.
