REGULAR MEETING

Council Chamber:

Mayor Stevenson presided at the Regular Meeting of Council held on the above date and place.

Mayor Stevenson called the meeting to order.

Borough Clerk VanScoy read the opening statement regarding the Open Public Meetings Act.

Mayor Stevenson asked all those present to join in the salute to the flag, which was conducted by Borough Clerk VanScoy.

Members present were: Council President Giovannitti, Councilman DiTonno, Councilman Giampola, Councilman Haynes, Councilman Holloway, Councilman Kidd.

PROCLAMATIONS: Amaya Reed Clark.

Mayor Stevenson presented a proclamation to volunteer/student/resident Amaya Reed Clark.

Miss Clark stated she likes volunteering as it makes people feel good about themselves and they feel happy.

Council President Giovannitti honored the Girls Track Team and their Coaches on their State Championship win.

Mayor Stevenson opened the floor to the public and asked anyone speaking to give their name, address and reminded everyone there was a five (5) minute time limit.

Councilman Giampola moved and Councilman DiTonno seconded to open the floor to the public at 7:32 p.m. All were in favor of the motion.

Councilman DiTonno moved and Council President Giovannitti seconded to close the floor to the public. All were in favor of the motion.

Council President Giovannitti moved and Councilman DiTonno seconded to receive, file the reports and adopt the minutes. All were in favor of the motion.

Letter of request from Emily Lopez, Paul Avenue, regarding Paul Avenue Street Cleanup & Gathering on August 3, 2019 from 8:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. They would like to have the road blocked from Thomson Avenue to Morton Avenue from 4:00 to 8:00 p.m. Council President Giovannitti moved and Councilman DiTonno seconded to receive, file the letter and approve the request contingent upon the Police Chief's recommendations. All were in favor of the motion.

MAYOR AND COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Finance Committee: Councilman Giampola, Chairman:

Councilman Giampola recommended introducing the 2019 Budget.

R. #95.19: 2019 BUDGET: – Introduction. Council President Giampola moved and Councilman Giampola seconded to introduce the 2019 budget and schedule the public hearing on July 9, 2019 and adopt R. #95.19. Roll call: Ayes: Council

President Giovannitti, Councilman DiTonno, Councilman Giampola, Councilman Haynes, Councilman Holloway, Councilman Kidd. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Public Works Committee: Councilman Haynes, Chairman:

Councilman Haynes asked Borough Engineer Biermann to give an update on the projects that are going on. He stated a meeting will be set up with the Trash and Recycling Contractor regarding complaints that have been received.

Borough Engineer Biermann reported the Thomson Avenue Contract #1 is completed as well as the video storm sewer. He anticipates the concrete work starting tomorrow on the Thomson Avenue Contract #2 project and they will start paving in three (3) weeks. He is waiting on approval from USDA for the Pine Street Project that will go from Broad Street to Swedesboro Avenue for paving. There are test wells being drilled at each of the Water Treatment Plants. The contracts are in place for the 2017 NJDOT project on Spruce Street from Broad Street to Thomson Avenue and will be done in mid-August. There will be additional signage on Penn Line and Delaware Streets to make the intersections three (3) and four (4) way stop intersections.

Councilman Haynes thanked Councilman Holloway for recommending the stop signs.

Public Property Committee: Councilman Holloway, II, Chairman:

Councilman Holloway stated the Property Committee has met with a Real Estate Broker regarding the Mayor's housing initiative. They will put a couple of houses on some lots the Borough owns. It is moving forward. The Broker is from Paulsboro and so is the Developer. There will be another meeting coming next week.

Mayor Stevenson thanked Councilman Holloway for spearheading the meetings.

Public Safety Committee: Councilman DiTonno, Chairman:

Councilman DiTonno did not have anything to report.

Councilman Holloway congratulated Mayor Stevenson, Council President Giovannitti and Councilman DiTonno on their election win.

Community Betterment Committee: Councilman Kidd, Chairman:

Councilman Kidd congratulated Mayor Stevenson, Council President Giovannitti and Councilman DiTonno on their election win.

Councilman Kidd discussed the Barbecue event that was held at Fort Billings Park by resident William Kidd (aka Bill Bill). Mr. Kidd's aim was to try to pull the community together. There wasn't any alcohol or smoking and it turned out to be a beautiful event. Everything was free.

Councilman Kidd stated he is very proud of the Girls Track Team on winning the State Championship.

Construction and Licensing Committee: Council President Giovannitti,
Chairman:

Council President Giovannitti stated the Girls Track Team is excited on winning the State Championship and he is proud of their accomplishment. He thanked Chief Kille on implementing the Bicycle and Foot Patrols. Paulsboro students won three (3) Sportsmanship Awards at the Colonial Conference. He also stated Code Enforcement Officer Marra gave an excellent report on the status of the Code Office. There are properties that have to be looked at and are very bad. The Borough can revoke the rental registration on these properties. There will be grass issues that will be coming up. Anyone can report an issue on the Borough's website through GovPilot's "Report a Concern". He thanked all the Council, Departments and Administrator Jacobucci.

Mayor Stevenson stated there are only two (2) Code employees and he thanked Council President Giovannitti for heading up the Construction/Code Committee.

Mayor Stevenson also thanked Council President Giovannitti for chairing the last Regular Meeting. He reported on the Memorial Day event and will work with the VFW for next year. He thanked and congratulated Council President Giovannitti and Councilman DiTonno on their election win. He also thanked the Election workers and the Crossing Guards for keeping the children safe.

Mayor Stevenson also commented on Mr. Kidd's Barbecue event which he stated was a great event and he looked forward to next year. There have been some trash and recycling complaints that have to be addressed. He thanked the Elk's Lodge for honoring him. Also, he stated that himself and Council President Giovannitti are on the front page of the Tokyo newspaper.

Mayor Stevenson recognized National Gun Violence Awareness Day which will be held on the first Friday in June which will be June 7th. On that day, it is requested everyone wear orange to help raise awareness.

Councilman Kidd further reported there were two (2) Police Officers on Bicycle Patrol that attended Mr. Kidd's barbecue event at the Park and Mr. Kidd asked the Officers to have the Police Officers stop and eat.

Kyana Evans, 710 Clonmell Road, stated her trash has not been picked up.

Mayor Stevenson stated the trash contractors have been missing whole streets of trash pick-up.

Miss Evans stated all the trash is still there on Clonmell Road.

Mayor Stevenson stated the Borough needs the residents to call the Borough in order to keep track of the complaints.

Councilman Kidd suggested someone should show the trash contractors how to travel Paulsboro.

Eric Singleton and Jennifer Maden, 1501 South Commerce Street, wanted their concerns on public record that they are not happy with the reparations of their property.

Mayor Stevenson explained the Borough has an easement on their property for the Thomson Avenue project.

Marc Kamp, 250 West Broad Street, stated the Fourth of July letters went out in the mail last week and the theme of this year's parade is "What makes Paulsboro Great". There are two (2) string bands booked. Registration starts at 9:00 a.m., the parade will commence at 10:00 a.m. and it should end by 12:00 p.m.

Mr. Kamp also stated Paulsboro Day will be held on September 7th with a rain date of September 8th. This year there will also be a car show.

Mayor Stevenson thanked Mr. Kamp for all he has done.

Irma Stevenson, 216 East Jefferson Street, thanked everyone for the Memorial Day event and she thanked Mayor and Council who attended the event.


Councilman Giampola thanked Phil Weiss from Weiss' Hardware Store for donating the flags for the Memorial Day event.

There wasn't any further Borough business.
