Jennifer Turner is a Rowan University Alumni and certified in Professional Meeting Management from Temple University Center City (TUCC). She is an active member and volunteer for MAACME Membership, Conference Planning and Communication committees. Employed full-time at TJU in the Office of Continuing Professional Development; Jennifer manages 100 Regularly Scheduled Series and 101 Series Administrators across the Jefferson Enterprise local and statewide. Jennifer made history as the first African American woman elected to serve on the Paulsboro Council between 2012-2015. Previously she was a member of The Greater Paulsboro Chamber of Commerce.

Currently, sits on the Board for Gloucester County Commission for Women. She is involved and professionally volunteers with many other groups: Gloucester County Federation of Democratic Women, CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate) and Gloucester County Council for Young Children (GCCYC). Jennifer is a passionate Community Advocate and loves Wednesday Eve – a Women’s Ministry of Gloucester County Prayer Committee.

As councilmember, Jennifer is Chairperson to the Public Property Committee; a member of the Public Works Committee and Construction and Licensing Committee; and alternate member of Land Use Board Paulsboro.
