Dear Borough Resident;

Effective January 1, 2024, the Borough has hired a new Solid Waste (trash) contractor. For economies of manpower and price, the Borough contractor will use automated pick-up vehicles (side arm and rear loaders).

Prior to this date, each residential household will receive one container. The container has wheels and is RFID equipped (tracking). The trash must fit in the container with the lid closed in order to be picked up. If a residence needs an additional container, there will be a yearly rental fee of \$95.00. There are also a limited number of 45-gallon containers for those who feel they are unable to handle the larger container. Requests may be made through the Public Works Department.

- **After January 1, 2024, NO TRASH BAGS OR ANYTHING OUTSIDE OF THE CLOSED LID CONTAINERS WILL BE COLLECTED.**
- **RECYLCING** will no longer be collected curbside. A RECYLING DROP OFF POINT WILL BE PROVIDED ON Commerce Street on Wednesdays from 3 pm – 6 pm; and on Saturdays from 8 am to Noon. Only plastic bottle, cardboard, glass jars, and metal cans will be collected. Borough Hall has a more thorough poster of acceptable recycling.
- **BULK WASTE:** Metal and electronics devices will be picked up by the Borough on the first Friday of the Month. Other bulk items may be picked up by the Borough with an appointment and fee payment.

BULK GOODS – Certain Bulk goods will be collected by the Borough on the first Friday of every month, weather permitting. Electronic waste and metal only.

No other bulk items should be placed curbside.

OTHER BULK GOODS: May be picked up by Borough with appointment and payment of fee.

No construction debris, no tires, no house clean outs, no contractor debris, no paints, chemicals, or toxic items.
